2 Villa Borghese	Daisy Miller and Mr Giovanelli	While they are walking in the Pincio gardens, Daisy and Mr Giovanelli sit and look at the view of the Villa and then walk to the wall where they perhaps kiss.
3 Palace of the Caesars	Daisy Miller, Mr Giovanelli and Winterbourne	Daisy and Mr Giovanelli are visiting the ruins at the Palace of the Caesars and they accidentally meet Winterbourne. Winterbourne tries to tell Daisy that people are not happy with her seeing Mr Giovanelli and she tells him that she is engaged to Mr Giovanelli.
4 Caelian Hill	Winterbourne	Winterbourne goes to a dinner in a house on the Caelian Hill.
5 Colosseum	Winterbourne, Daisy Miller and Mr Giovanelli	Winterbourne visits the Colosseum late at night after a dinner party and discovers Daisy and Mr Giovanelli also visiting. Winterbourne warns Daisy about Roman fever and Mr Giovanelli insists it was Daisy's wish to see the Colosseum.
