


A funny competition

Every year on the Spring bank holiday (the last Monday in May) a quite funny event can be watched in Gloucestershire: the Cooper's Hill Cheese Rolling.

Since the middle of the 19th century, the village of Brockworth in the County of Gloucestershire in South West England has been known for its cheese rolling race, the Cooper's Hill Cheese Rolling. Some even say that this event goes back to Roman times.

Originally, the event was for the people who lived in this village. In the course of time the event has become more and more popular and people from all over the world are now among competitors and spectators.

The cheese wheel that is used is a Double Gloucester hard cheese. The cheese weighs about 9 lb (about 4 kilos) and is supplied by a local cheesemaker. At the start it is decorated with ribbons. During the Second World War, when food was rationed, a wooden wheel with a

small piece of cheese in its centre was used instead.

The race itself looks like this: The cheese is rolled from the top of the hill, and immediately competitors run after it and chase it. Their aim is to catch the cheese. However, this is almost impossible as the cheese wheel is ahead of the runners and reaches speeds up to 70 mph (112 km/h). So the winner is the person who first passes the finishing line getting the cheese as a prize.

The race is not without risks. Spectators may be hit or even knocked over by the cheese rolling down the hill. Therefore, for safety reasons, in the 2013 race foam wheels were used instead. But the prize was a cheese wheel.
