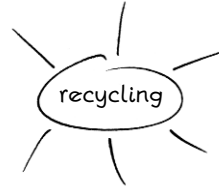
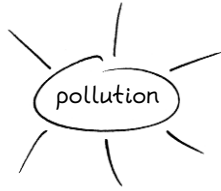


1 Environment vocabulary: pollution and recycling

In Unit 10 you read about the state of the planet or the environment, brainstorm words connected with pollution and recycling and write them on the word wheels below.

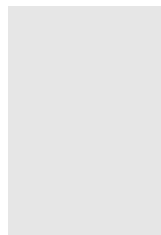
