## Home sweet home

### Teacher's Notes

**Preparation:**

Copy one activity sheet for every learner.

**In class:**

Hand out the activity sheets. Explain to your students that the object of the activity is to find out more about each other's homes while practising the vocabulary of the unit. Students should try to find classmates who have or do the things listed on the activity sheet. To do so, they must move around the classroom asking and answering questions with "do", such as "Do you live in an apartment?" If a classmate gives an affirmative answer, students should note down his/her name in the second column of their activity sheet. Emphasize that students should meet up with just one partner at a time and ask only one question each before moving on to a new partner. This keeps the activity dynamic.

When the students have filled their sheet with names or you have run out of time, ask everyone to sit down. Ask questions to get feedback from the group about what they have learned.
