**Student's sheet**

**Which? Who?***Preparation:*

Make one copy of the student's sheet for each student as a handout for after they have done the activity. Make another copy of the student's sheet for each pair of students and cut up the different parts along the lines.

*In class:*

1. Distribute one set of cut-up sentences to each pair of students.
2. Ask students to find matches. There may be more than one correct solution. Walk around, monitor and help, if necessary.
3. Then ask one or two students to read their sentences.
4. In pairs, students now rewrite the sentences with their own endings.
5. After a few minutes ask one or two students to write their own sentences on the board. Use them as a basis for a conversation.
6. At the end of the lesson hand out a copy with the complete sentences to each student.
