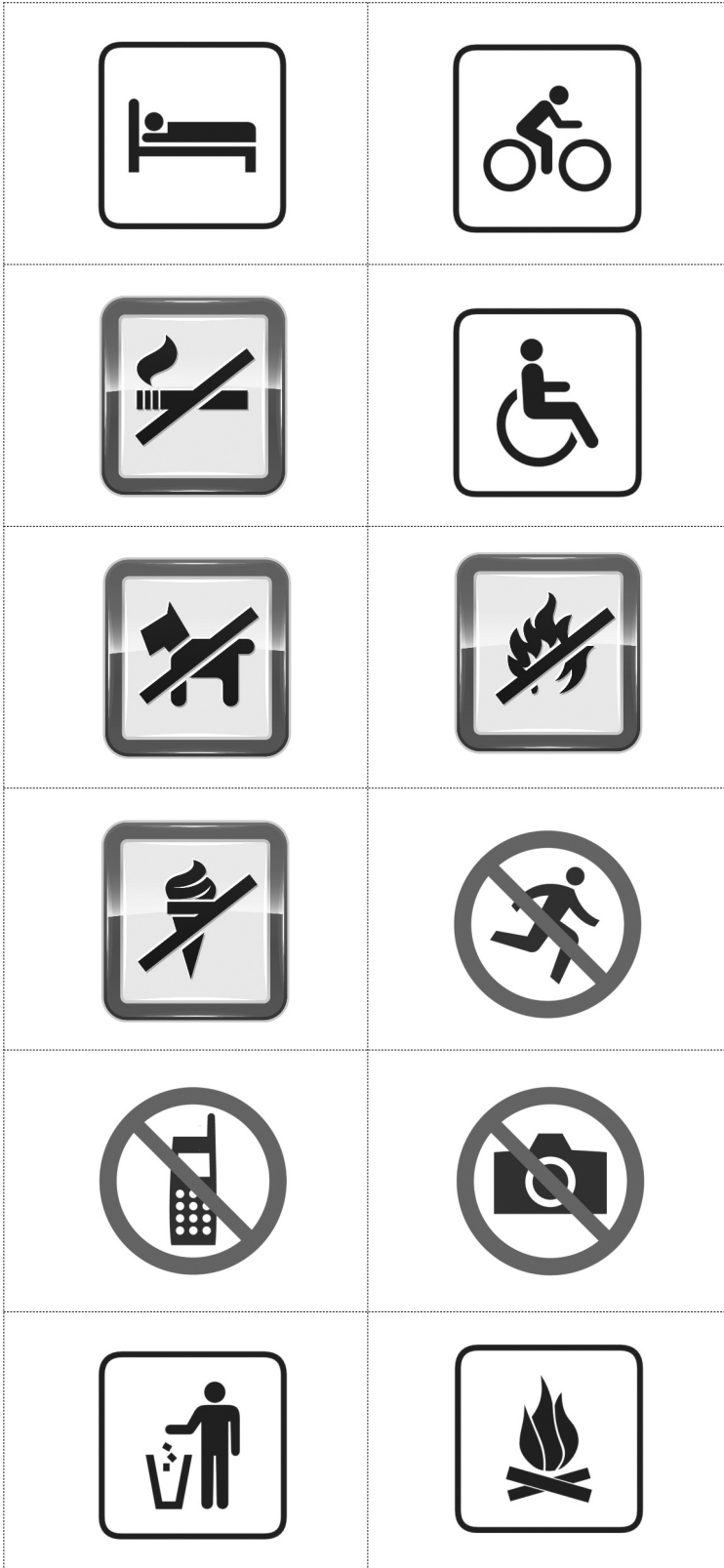


Signs! Signs! Signs!



Signs! Signs! Signs!

Preparation:

Copy and cut out the twelve cards (sheet 1 and 2) with the different signs for each group of three to four students. Bring along some blank cards.

In class:

The aim of this activity is to practise modal verbs (*must, have to, mustn't, don't have to, can, be allowed to*) and recommendations (*Be careful! Drive slowly!*).

Tell students you are going to hand out some signs. Students get a set of twelve sign cards and twelve blank cards. Students write a text for each sign, one per card. Make sure students understand that funny ideas are welcome.

They then shuffle the signs and cards and pass them on to another group who has to find the correct matches. Check at the end and find the funniest sign text. Have a small reward ready for the winning team.

Extension activity:

If your class has no more than 12 students you can do this with the whole group.

Pin or tape the signs to a board and ask students to write their texts on Post-its. Then collect the Post-its and hang them on the board as well. Students then match signs and texts.
