

Weekend visitors

Imagine that some people from another country are coming to visit you for the weekend. You want to plan what you are going to do with them. Think about your ideas on the following. Then talk to your partner(s) and make up a programme for the visitors. Think about the following:

- what you should tell them about your country
- what you can show them in your town, area or country
- how you want to travel
- what you want to give them to eat and drink
- what games you can play with them
- what you can do in the evening
- where they can go shopping
- what they can buy
- where they can stay
- what cultural programme you can organize
- what to do in good and bad weather
- ...

Weekend visitors*Preparation:*

If possible, bring tourist brochures from the area or ask students to bring these.
Copy one sheet for each student.

In class:

Give each student a sheet and ask them to work on their own and think of ideas for as many of the points as possible. Tell them they can also add other ideas.

Then, in groups, students work out a programme for the visitors. It is important that they agree on the programme.

The programmes can be made into posters and hung up around the room. Give a prize for the most interesting programme.

Extension activity:

Students can write an email to the visitors and give an outline of the programme, or they can write a recipe for a local dish.
