Teacher's notes

Preparation:

The aim of this activity is to get students to ask questions about a life story. Copy the sheet once for each pair of students and then cut each sheet in half.

In class:

Brainstorm some questions which can be asked to find out about someone's life story. Make sure students know how to ask different types of Wh-questions. Ask if they know who Margaret Thatcher is. Make sure that students know how to do the exercise and don't ask "What is number ...?" If necessary, do one or two questions with the whole group.
